## SOFTWARE AND DATA ARCHIVING: OUR LIBRARIAN CODES IN PYTHON

Through the context of a software preservation and emulation nightmare, I'll be dispelling myths that librarianship is something focused only on the past and prove that it is a profession actively growing with the changing needs of scholars - especially computer scientists. I'll also be describing my research interests in software and data preservation and highlighting areas where we can collaborate across our departments.
